PAST PERFECT CONTINUOUS PRESENT PERFECT CONTINUOUS

I had been studying English for 5 years before I have been studying English for five years. I will have been studying English for over two hours by

the time you arrive. or

I am going to have been studying English for over two

hours by the time you arrive.
