

VERB TENSE CHART

PAST (SIMPLE)

I walked
I studied English when I lived in England.

PRESENT (SIMPLE)

I walk
I study English every day.

FUTURE (SIMPLE)

I will walk
I will help you study English or
I am going to study English next year.

PAST PERFECT

I had walked
I had studied English before I moved here.

PRESENT PERFECT

I have walked
I have studied English in several countries.

FUTURE PERFECT

I will have walked
I will have studied every tense by next week.
I am going to have studied every tense by next week.

PAST CONTINUOUS

I was walking
I was studying English when you called today.

PRESENT CONTINUOUS

I am walking
I am studying English now.

FUTURE CONTINUOUS

I will be walking
I will be studying English when you arrive tomorrow. or
I am going to be studying English when you arrive tomorrow.

PAST PERFECT CONTINUOUS

I had been studying English for 5 years before moving here.

PRESENT PERFECT CONTINUOUS

I have been studying English for five years.

FUTURE PERFECT CONTINUOUS

I will have been studying English for over two hours by the time you arrive. or
I am going to have been studying English for over two hours by the time you arrive.
